Who is Cherokee County Electric Co-op?

Cherokee County Electric Cooperative Association is a member-owned electric service provider. Distribution cooperatives such as CCECA buy electricity from wholesale providers and arrange for its transmission and distribution to members through the co-op's lines. Being a member of a co-op has added benefits. Members/owners elect the Board of Directors who govern the co-op. Also, each year CCECA shares its excess revenue – money it collects above what it takes to run the business – with its members. This money is called capital credits.

CCECA was started in 1939 to provide power to rural customers. The Cooperative now serves parts of 4 counties including Cherokee, Smith, Rusk, and Nacogdoches. Currently, the Cooperative has over 3,400 miles of line averaging 6.1 meters per mile of line for a total of over 21,000 meters.

Cherokee County Electric Cooperative employs more than 70 people, many of whom live in the cooperative's service area. Many are co-op members just like you. All CCECA employees have a vested interest in the cooperative, and live and work by the Cooperative Foundation that signifies the values of Safety, Courage, Respect, Reliability, Community and Love.
